Income

Donations

After the initial flurry when we started up, donations trickled in in 2014 to a total of £186.

Calendars

Payments for most of the calendars sold in 2013 continued to come in and we received £417.30 (after payments for p&p were deducted)

Commission

We received £40 commission from a sale of a John Perkin painting.

Expenditure

Events

- * Yorkshire Sculpture Park, 22nd March a Yorkshire Quaker Arts Project linking in with the work of James Turrell. We hired a room for members and friends to meet and have some refreshments.
- * John Perkin Retrospective exhibition , 12th May to 10th August, corridor at Friends House

The costs incurred were for advertising, transport of the paintings and dry letter transfers and refreshments on opening night It was a 'test' piece for QAN exhibiting at FH and it was very well received We spent £353 in all, but we had significant contributions in kind that would have added another £1500.

- * Annual examination of accounts £20
- * Other regular expenditures were for advertising and room hire for meetings. Website Honorarium £100 payment not cleared in 2014. Workshops such as the ones we've had in Woodbrooke and Swarthmoor have paid for themselves, in fact the one in Swarthmoor this year we made a surplus of over £500 which will be very helpful for future projects

Current developments

We have started paying Jean Chettle, our web-site developer £30 a month, plus domain name and hosting.

For continued development
We need to have sufficient funds for:

- 1. Maintenanceofourwebsite, and for further developments
- Administrative expenses (egexamination of accounts). We need to payoccasional travel
 expenses for members and invited guests with special skills working on our behalf –
 for example, the exhibitions group
- 3. Settingupexhibitions, as we have seen is costly, but well worth the effort for show casing the work of Quaker artists
- 4. Wearelookingforafundraiser.
